



**Travel Policy Update  
07-18-2022**

Due to the ever-changing recommendations of the CDC, DPH, and OEC, the following is an update to our COVID Travel Policy.

- A negative rapid test must be submitted before returning to class. If the child is 3 years old or older, they must wear a mask for the 10-day period following their return.

All policies are subject to change as warranted by current COVID cases and guidelines.

Dear Parents,

Now that there has been a roll out of COVID vaccines and the Governor has lifted or amended several policies for the State of Connecticut, I would like to update you on Little Blessings current quarantine, travel and vacation policies.

1. If your child has been exposed to a positive case of COVID, they will need to continue to quarantine for 14 days regardless if they have a negative test result.
2. If you travel outside of the State of Connecticut, it is Little Blessings' policy that your child and all family members who traveled together must either have a negative COVID test performed no earlier than 72 hours upon return to CT, or quarantine for 14 days. This means if you return on a Saturday night, the earliest you can test is Wednesday morning. Once proof of a negative test result is submitted for your family, your child may return to school and will continue to be monitored for any symptoms that may develop.

The reasoning for our policy is that we are teaching children who are unvaccinated and may be carrying the COVID infection, even if they are asymptomatic. The above policies will stay in place to protect all our children, families and staff until the Board of Little Blessings, under the guidance of the CDC, deems it safe to change.

A reminder that if your child does not attend Little Blessings for any of the above quarantine policies, you are still responsible for the full weekly tuition.
